

ESSR ENDORSEMENT of COURSES, WORKSHOPS, MASTERCLASSES, WEBINARS

Introduction

In the past, the ESSR endorsement and logo was given to a series of MSK imaging courses organized by third parties and other societies as part of the Diploma accreditation process under the supervision of the ESSR Education Committee. This procedure is no longer active following the introduction of a CME-based accreditation system required by ESR for ESSR endorsement criteria.

Use of ESSR Logo

Because ESSR has now a strong educational platform with multifaceted activities and educational courses in the field of MSK radiological discipline are now proposed by the Subcommittees as part of their institutional activity, there is no apparent reason to grant the ESSR endorsement and logo to courses/workshops/masterclasses/webinars that are organized external to our society.

However, if an international scientific society (incl. MSK radiological and non-radiological) wishes to get ESSR endorsement/active participation for some of its educational activities, a formal written request has to be sent to office@essr.org. Discussion will follow within the ESSR Executive Committee and decision will be based on a kind of partnership and cooperation agreement that needs to be well-balanced and considered relevant/strategic.

If an ESSR member organizes a course/workshop/masterclass as part of her/his private individual work, this activity cannot be endorsed by ESSR and the Society cannot grant its logo.

Taking part in external meetings on behalf of the ESSR

ESSR Members must not take part in external activities *on behalf of ESSR* without informing the Education Committee and Executive Committee beforehand.
