Agreement between the European Society of Musculoskeletal Radiology (ESSR) and RSSA/SAMSIG

Dear Prof. van Rensburg

The purpose of this agreement is a collaboration between the European Society of Musculoskeletal Radiology (ESSR) and the affiliated society **RSSA/SAMSIG** aiming at supporting communication, education and research for promoting musculoskeletal radiology in the widest sense of the term (according of § 2 of the ESSR statutes). A special focus is on recognised and qualified postgraduate education of musculoskeletal imaging. The shared activities will be implemented under the umbrella of the Musculoskeletal Intersociety Forum of the International Skeletal Society (ISS).

#### 1. Membership:

ESSR is offering all benefits for the members of the affiliated society including reduced fees for the ESSR meetings. The affiliated society provides a list (template provided by ESSR) of their members wishing to join the ESSR at the reduced membership rate. The transmission of member information to the ESSR requires the personal confirmation and willingness of the individual to be collected by the affiliated society according to data protection laws. ESSR includes all individual members according to this list in the ESSR member database. The affiliated society collects the reduced membership fees of the individual members and pays the collective group contribution to the ESSR within the financial year.

#### 2. Joint activities:

- a) Exchange of information (announcement of meetings and other activities) and dissemination via the communication channels (homepage with links, newsletters and other forms of mailing, social media) by both societies.
- b) The both societies may invite at least one speaker to their meetings, organize joint sessions within a meeting, or whole meetings. The inviting society is responsible for covering the speaker's registration fee, accommodation (maximum of 3 nights) and travel expenses (economy class flight ticket, pre-budgeted amount to be agreed). The ESSR representative will be invited to give a brief report about the activity for publication in the ESSR communication channels. If the ESSR is asked to provide the patronage of a meeting of the affiliated society, then ESSR permits the use of its logo
